Our next exciting adventure is only a few days away on Saturday April 27th, 2024. The weather outlook according to the NWS ABQ for the area we are visiting is a typical spring day in NM. Cool morning, small chance of precip, and some wind, and cloudy. <u>Click here</u> for weather info.

Driving time: about 90 minutes from ABQ.

Time: 9 am into the afternoon

Lunch : in Mountainair or bring a pack lunch.

The breakdown of the day from David and Becky:

From the Big I travel south on I-25 just south of the airport to Rio Bravo Blvd SE. Head West one block and make a U-Turn at the traffic light, Broadway Blvd SE. After the U-Turn head East toward the freeway. Just before the freeway there will be a Maverik Fuel Station on your right. This is where we will gather.

The local frequency will be simplex, 146.460. We will also monitor the club repeater, 442.750, as we head to the meeting location.

It is about a one-hour drive from our meeting location to the ABO, so, for the best use of the day, we would like to depart at 9am from the Maverik.

<u>Make plans to arrive about 0845 so we can leave at 0900.</u> If you are traveling on your own, the address for the ABO ruins is 69 Ruins Road, Mountainair, NM 87036.
